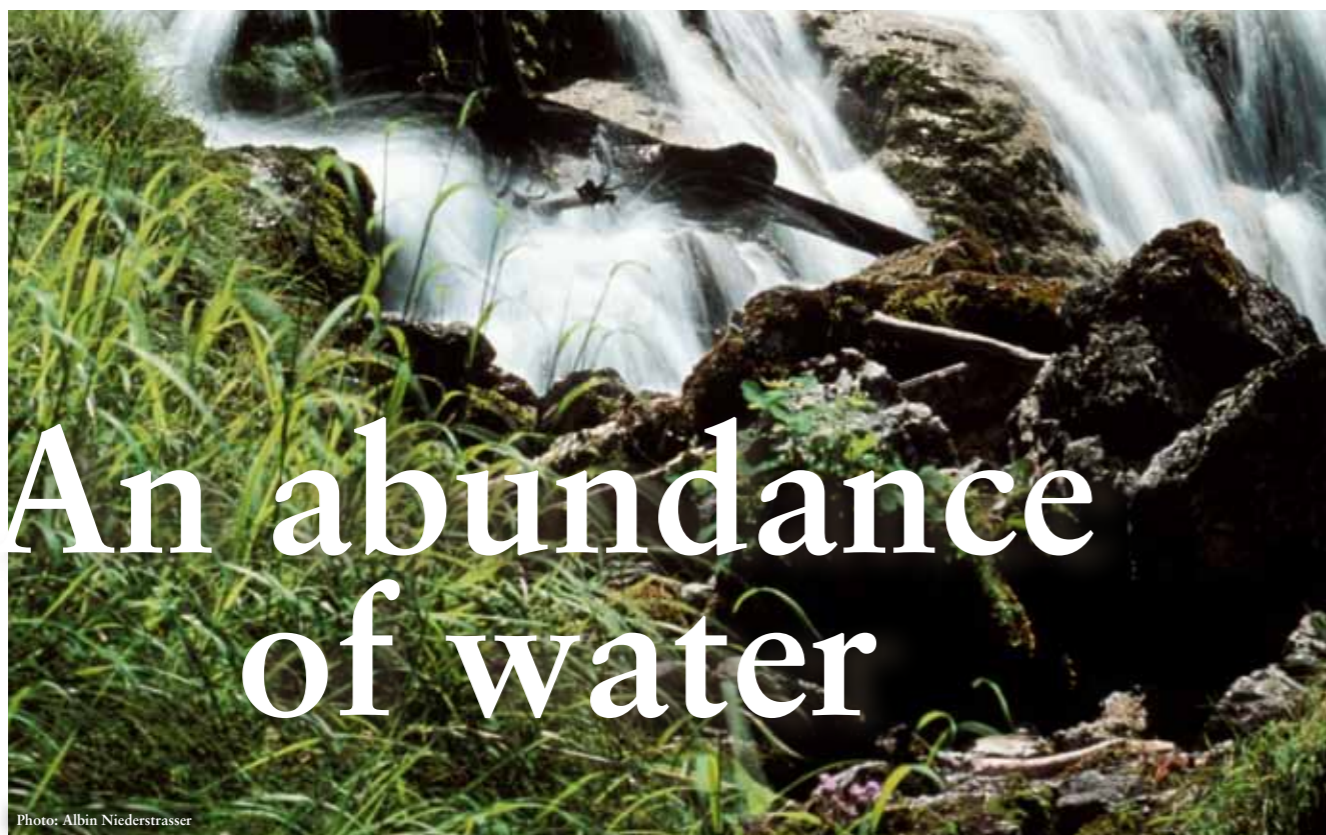

An abundance of water

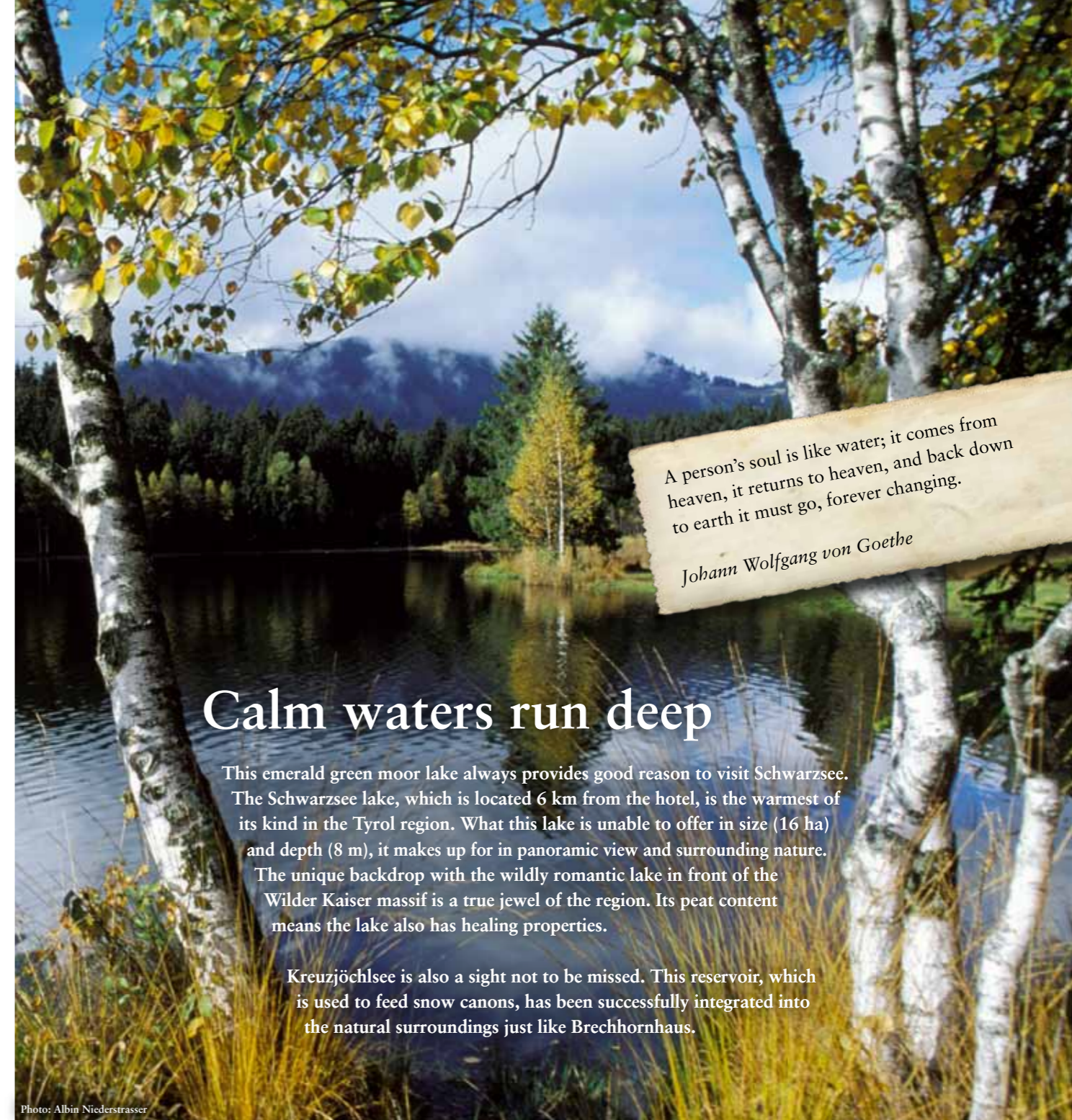

Calm waters run deep

This emerald green moor lake always provides good reason to visit Schwarzsee. The Schwarzsee lake, which is located 6 km from the hotel, is the warmest of its kind in the Tyrol region. What this lake is unable to offer in size (16 ha) and depth (8 m), it makes up for in panoramic view and surrounding nature. The unique backdrop with the wildly romantic lake in front of the Wilder Kaiser massif is a true jewel of the region. Its peat content means the lake also has healing properties.

Kreuzjochlsee is also a sight not to be missed. This reservoir, which is used to feed snow canons, has been successfully integrated into the natural surroundings just like Brechhornhaus.

Go off the beaten track ...

Mother Nature must have worked really hard when she was creating this spot of land. Rich with soft grassy mountains, steep limestone rocks, peaceful moor lakes and gushing streams, deep gorges and gentle plateaus – let the Kitzbühel Alps satisfy all your walking urges.

Lisi's insider tip:
take the bull by the horns and explore the wilderness in Spertental!

You can best quench your thirst for knowledge on the **nature trail**, which snakes from the hotel's Hintenbach Alp to Hochleger Schöntal Alp. From there, the courageous can tackle the Großer Rettenstein mountain and enjoy romantic sunrises early in the morning.

Those who prefer to amble through the woods can take the **forest trail** on the decent to the Stallbachkar Alp. Along the forest track, hikers will come to encounter the bulls that graze there. This is why the locals call this alp "Stieralm" (bull alp). It's not just the bulls that are attracted to this little place.

In mid-June, the alp plays host to the annual Hengstaufrtrieb (traditional horse fight). This breathtaking event is a special treat for anyone who likes horses. The stallions are bursting with strength at this time of year, thus to save them from tedious rank fights all summer long, they are invited to enter the ring at the very start of the Alpine season. Within a few hours, the powerful horses face up to the dual and fight it out amongst them to determine who the champion is — this champion then takes on the role of lead stallion. This process ensures that there are no more dangerous rank fights for the rest of the Alpine season.

Back at the Hintenbach Alp, we can rebuild our strength with fresh buttermilk and hearty cheese at "Kasplatzl", the hotel's own show dairy.

Mountains of healthy food

“Heart – what more do you want?” the palate asks the stomach upon a visit to Kasplatzl. The new show dairy, opening in summer 2010, is perfectly in tune with today’s tastes – because when the cows graze placidly on the Alps, they supply very precious resources. And these resources can be allowed to fully mature right in the heart of the Tyrolean Mountains.

It smells to me

The cheese cellar stores all the real stinkers. Alpine cheese matures for between 4 months and 1 year at a pleasant temperature of 12–14 °C and 90–95 % humidity. The blocks are snugly arranged in rows, one after the other. Around 100 Alpine cheeses have a place here. One weighs around 35 kg. These heavy-weights certainly demand a lot: approx. 12 l milk is required for 1 kg of this type of cheese. But how does such a heavy lump remain so beautiful in shape? The curd is pumped with whey in a round mould. This has holes at the bottom and the whey drains slowly through them. So everything stays in order. If you want to experience the whole thing up close, take a visit to our show dairy. It’s best to visit between 10 and 12 (daily), because the cheese looks its best after a nice quiet night and a good rest!

Enjoy your meal!

While the milk gets its beauty sleep at night, the cream rises to the surface. Then it can be gently skimmed off the top early in the morning. After a short blast of heat, it is vigorously beaten. After being whipped in a stirred tank reactor, fine lumps emerge that will later be used to make butter.

The lumps are separated from the liquid and the drink of the Alpine gods comes into being: deliciously sour buttermilk.

“Buttermilk is like an argument, the more you stir, the more sour it becomes”.


