## A sense of delight on the Hausberg mountain

The spectacular Hahnenkamm races or Hahnenkammrennen is one of the most appealing ski competitions in the world, from a historical as well from a cultural and technical perspective.

Ski racers have been hurtling down the slopes here since the 1930's but it was only in 1967 that the demanding event was included in the official list of Ski World Cup events. With a downhill gradient of 85 %, the Mouse Trap or Mausefalle section of the slope (know as the Streif) reduces even the most hardened downhill skiers to silence.

Two-time World Champion Alpine skier Stephan Eberharter said that the first time he skied on the Streif he “was terrified that he was going to die!” The skiers have to fly through the air for a distance of about 60 metres without a parachute on this section of the Streif. Despite the dangers, the event has been cancelled or the course shortened only occasionally due to poor fog or wind conditions. The event is extremely popular with spectators and the record attendance figure is 100,000 spectators drawn from around the entire world.

The record time for skiing down the Streif remains safely in Austrian hands: Fritz Strobl is the only person so far ever to complete the course in a time of 1m 51.58 seconds. It is no wonder then that when Robert Redford filmed “The Downhill Racer” here in 1969 he used a stunt double for the action scenes!



# Exhilarating Mountain Drive



Up we go this winter with the new Maierl Liftkette ski lift. Guests staying at the Elisabeth Hotel will soon be truly spoiled with choices when it comes to deciding how to go up to the ski slopes.

Now that the Pengelsteinbahn ski lift, which is just one bus stop away from our hotel, is so busy, the decision has been made to modernise the older Maierl chair lift. Skiers can now travel up to the mountains in a continuous loop

ski lift system from the current Maierl I valley station to the Maierl II mountain station. As if all this was not enough, there is now also an 8-seat chairlift with a weather-resistant hood running from the Ochsalm to the summit. This means that there are now two ski lifts right next to the hotel which can take you up to the pistes at the speed of the wind. But you can still make the descent in the way that you have always done: the Obwiesen descent still ends right in front of the hotel door.

*In my first season in Switzerland a customer asked me for a bottle of feudent (a Swiss white wine) and I thought he had said a bottle of Fanta so I brought him one!*

#### Do you prefer to cook for yourself or to eat out?

*I would much rather cook for myself: Racks of lamb with balsamic chocolate sauce and apple red cabbage. But it is also nice to go out for a meal and spoil yourself every now and then.*

#### Do you have any other passions apart from wine?

*Sport. It gives me a sense of balance and helps to clear my head for my work.*

Daniela Mayer is certainly not lacking in protective instincts either: She knows exactly what is important in a well-run restaurant. “You must have a really excellent team to make sure that everything runs smoothly.” She is thus always working hard to make sure that everyone from the newest apprentice on up to the most experienced old hand is working comfortably.
